President Lisa Rackley discussed the petting zoo for the Annual Wylie Arts Festival and volunteers and animals are needed, but there are two other conflicts on the same day to include a McKinney Show and Concession Stand Fundraiser. Various LDE teams went to District and came in 3rd overall out of 22 different schools; Jr. Quiz team received the highest score in the state. 20 students will be going to Area Competition; CDE planning discussed; Student Fundraiser discussed-Fruit and Candle Sales-Mr. Parr is asking that 15-20 items be sold for each student. The fundraiser will help with Stock Shows and Competitions. T-Shirts are still for sale and available for purchase. This year there will be a District Banquet and 30 students will be attending. For Wylie FFA, the students chose to have their own banquet this year and Wylie East is welcome to attend, but the focus will be our student's accomplishments and awards.

Colette Rogers discussed the texting/email for updates and parents were encouraged to sign up to receive continual updates.
