

# Meeting Minutes

## **Wylie High School FFA Supporter Club Thursday, December 6, 2012**

### **Committee Updates**

Monica Williamson-Discussed the Art Festival and Parade on December 1, 2012 and received a great review from the City of Wylie Representative-Craig Kelly. \$166 was collected as donations (amount will be accurately posted on Treasurer's Report next month).

Colette Rogers-Fundraising Chari discussed Riley Roundup for MS Concession stand Fundraiser in Denison, Texas. Total funds raised around \$750 (amount will be accurately posted on Treasurer's Report next month).

Colette Rogers-Wylie High Scholarship Committee member had a meeting with Wylie East on Tuesday and there were concerns about Wylie East being able to fund \$2500 for the 2012-2013 Scholarship. However Wylie High School will maintain the \$2500 scholarship amount for the school year and will continue to raise funds for the scholarship fund for future scholarships. There were a number of years that no money was put into the Scholarship Fund. In addition animals can be donated toward the Scholarship Fund as part of the Wylie Show and Sale proceeds. Colette Rogers and Lisa Rackley will work together to update the wylieffa.com Scholarship page to be available in January 2013 to eligible students.

Colette Rogers-T-shirts-there have been a number of parents that have requested a Wylie FFA Sweatshirt that will require a minimum of 12 shirts and pre-payment of shirts for those members who would like one. We also have Orange, Maroon, and Car Show T-Shirts remaining if anyone is interested in purchasing.

Mr. Nick (Ag teacher) discussed upcoming Events to include the Wylie High and Wylie East FFA Student Dance to be held on December 15, 2012 from 7 -9 pm at Wylie High School Cafeteria. The cost is \$5.00 for food.

Mr. Nick also discussed Collin County. We will need volunteers to work the concession stand again this year, but only the start-up and then grounds cleanup. The Start date will be on January 7, 2013 from 5-7 pm. A total of six (6) volunteers are needed, three (3) from Wylie and three (3) from Wylie East. Hair net and gloves will be provided or you can bring and wear a hat. The Clean-up day will be on Friday, January 11, 2013 around 8-8:30 pm to finish. Volunteers are needed to clean up the bleachers, pickup trash and sweep the common area and bathrooms.

Ken Carpenter made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Colette Rogers and the meeting ended at 7:03 pm. Next meeting will be held on January 3, 2013.
